I. Call to Order

Lisa presented a financial update and accounts are healthy. The Friends have spent just under \$600 recently on programming, materials, and supplies.

VI. Old Business, New Business, and Upcoming Events

Late fall and winter activities provided much enjoyment for crafty participants, including the wreath workshop and the DIY Holiday event. The Yumraiser Fundraiser also made a modest profit.

Many upcoming classes are also being developed and promoted. A watercolor craft will be held on Feb. 7 at 6:30 PM. A fly-fishing workshop will be held in March. An Oscars night red carpet experience will take place at the library on Mar. 7 at 6:30 PM, with participants receiving props, photos, and a swag bag, before a scheduled 7 PM lecture. Tea blending classes will be held at Herbs Make Scents on Mar. 10 and Mar. 24 at a cost of \$20; the Friends will pay \$10 for each registration, and classes are limited to eight participants.

The pebble art class with Orange Jellyfish was well attended with eleven participants. Orange Jellyfish will host an April 28 flower pebble art class, and the Friends voted to pay \$10 per registration. A Zentangle class will also be scheduled for late spring.

The seed library stock needs to be re-packaged, so supplies will be ordered and the Friends will work on the repackaging.

A Woo Sox baseball event is being considered for May or June as a community get-together.
