- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:03PM.
- 2. December 2023 minutes were unanimously approved.

3. Friends

- The holiday events were very successful. Holiday Wreaths was full at 12 participants, and the craft day had approximately 25 attendees and plenty of volunteers.

4. Director's Report

- Staff will be meeting on February 6th.

Budget

- 6 months into the budget cycle, 44.8% of the budget has been spent.
- Both Operations and Salaries are running 5% below target.
- FY25 budget has been submitted. An additional 9 staff hours and 11 Children's Librarian hours have been requested. The contractual increase to the Director's Salary is also in the total. The Books line has been increased by \$1,000 to \$69,100 which is a state-mandated increase to ensure that purchases of circulating materials remain at 19% of the total budget.

6. Projects

- Weeding and shifting adult fiction continues. Andrew has been moving the weeded books to the rectory garage.
- Trying to get a date to meet with faculty at BVT to discuss website overhaul.
- Andrew will be attending Aspen workshops, which will be both patron focused and administrative focused.
- The paving issue involving the abutter seems to have stalled. Andrew continues to reach out to the Town Administrator in hopes of getting things moving.
- The Asset Inventory Form has been submitted to the Town Administrator.

7. Carriage House

- The Carriage House has been secured and sealed off.
- Andrew has been trying to get updates from the town.
- There will be a public hearing regarding the historical status and future of the Carriage House on January 25th, 2024 at 7:00PM.

8. Rectory

- The Taft Library Rectory Working Group will be meeting again next week to discuss vision. Do any of the 3 original plans meet today's needs?
