- Potential liability to town until ADA compliant





Potential Solutions

Option	Cost	Size	Result
Make Taft Library ADA compliant	In excess of \$500,000	2,200 sf	Less space for collection and programs.
North Avenue	\$3.5 million	6,000 sf	New construction on town land
North Avenue (with grant money)	\$4.0 million (after grant)	12,000+ sf	Grants uncertain, extended process, higher operating budget
Addition to Taft Library	\$3 – 3.5 million	6,000 sf	Almost as expensive as North Ave.
Taft Library + Police building	No estimate for renovation	2,200 sf + 2,400 sf	50 to 100% increase in staffing costs, ADA repair work remains








